SYSTEM MODIFICATIONS

Subsequent to our first end of quarter update last month, we have made a few minor changes to the system. The developer has not been able to track down the cause to date, but it appears some clubs did not receive all the attachments that were sent out in the end of March update. To allow you to check that you received all the attachments that are being sent, at the bottom of the body of the email will be a list of all attachments that are being sent. If this list does not match what is actually attached, please contact the Centre with a list of what you have not received.

We also discovered after the update that some new players that were created in very early April, were mistakenly included in the March update. The 5 clubs involved have all been issued with a credit note to reverse these incorrectly charged items.

We now have a crowd of Emerald Grand Masters. Well, at least three! Congratulations to Paul Lavings on becoming the third person to achieve the rank of Emerald Grand Master. COMMUNICATIONS

There seems to be some confusion about how the Centre communicates with clubs. I will re-iterate, wherever possible, we will communicate with a club via email, using the email address recorded against the Club Masterpoint Secretary. Currently the only exceptions to this are the registration cards and promotion certificates, both of which are printed on pre-printed stationary, and your quarterly Statement, which is generated from a third party financial package.

I have received numerous requests, often from Treasurers, stating they have received their Statement but not the invoice! I find this disappointing as the invoice would have been emailed to the Club Masterpoint Secretary prior to the actual mail being posted to clubs, so would have arrived well in advance of the Statement.

PLEASE pass on any invoice sent to you to the appropriate person within your club. You can just forward the original system generated email to your treasurer. You do not even have to print it out! Don't forget you can look online to see what outstanding monies might be owing at any time.
