### B4c ALLOCATION FOR 2021

Your B4c allocation for 2021 was determined in the end of September update just completed.

You will now see on the website, under the **Club List** option, both your current B4c allocation for 2020, and your new allocation for 2021 against your club. The column of 2020 figures will remain showing until the start of 2021, at which time, as you would have used all your 2020 allocation by then, it will be removed.

Your B4c Session Entitlements report will be emailed (or posted) as part of the September mail-out. You can use this report to keep track of your various B4c sessions you have planned for next year. At no stage should you ever return that report. It is purely for your own internal club use.

As per usual for all pdf reports, they will be placed on the website where you can print another copy in the future if you lose the one sent to you with this update. You can do this via the **Show Club Documents** option on the website.

A report for ALL clubs will also be uploaded to the website after the end of year update, as no one will then need the old report that is there now. That report can be accessed via the **Download** page if needed.

If you failed to get your green points to us prior to the monthly deadline, then don't bother asking if something can now be done.

*It cannot!!*

The B4c allocation calculations have already been done in the September update, and cannot be altered after the update is run.

Of our 350+ clubs, there were nearly 270 that needed their normal allocation adjusted due to COVID this year. What this means is that those clubs 2021 calculation produced a lower B4c allocation than what they received for 2020. So, all those clubs allocations were increased to what

they received in 2020 so they would not be disadvantaged due to the forced cessation of F2F bridge.

They will all receive the same allocation they received in 2020 for 2021. If your club received the same or a greater allocation for 2021, your club will be given that allocation.

### STATEMENTS

Your Q3/20 quarterly Statements will be mailed to all clubs in early October. **Please** check the total amounts owing, and only pay what is outstanding.

The total shown will match any invoices issued to you, unless you have overpaid in the past, and you should only pay the amount shown on the Statement, NOT the sum of your invoices.

There were 3 clubs with a credit amount prior to running the September update (18 last year and 15 the year before). The number is down as the Centre has made a concerted effort to return these duplicate/overpayments.

There were also 20 clubs with overdue accounts. Meaning they have not paid within the 90 day period, so their accounts are now overdue. Hopefully those clubs will be able to pay as soon as possible.

### 2021 FEES & CHARGES

A few years ago the ABF Management Committee decided to apply small annual increases to our fees and charges in line with a CPI increase, instead of applying larger increases every few years, which is what used to happen in the past.

Unfortunately the Management Committee have not informed the Centre of their intentions for 2021 at this stage. Normally they notify the Centre in time for this Newsletter.

I am sure they will notify clubs in due course. Please be patient.
