MONEY MATTERS

During June clubs in danger of having an overdue account by the end of June were all emailed reminding them to settle their outstanding invoices.

This reduced the number of overdue accounts from 32 at the start of June to 13 clubs by COB on 30th June. Despite two email reminders, regrettably we have been forced to charge a late fee to 3 clubs from NSW, 5 from VIC, 3 from QLD and 2 from SA.

The amounts owed ranged anywhere from \$1.27 through to \$2456.00, with the overall total overdue being \$7923.12.

Thank you to all those clubs that settled their accounts before the June deadline. Clubs with overdue accounts please pay asap.

On the flip side, we also had 7 clubs in credit as at COB on 30th June. There were 3 from NSW, 2 from VIC and 1 each from QLD and WA. The credit amounts ranged from \$0.10 through to \$89.08, with the overall total credit being \$288.16.

When we issued the Q2/24 quarterly invoices, 5 of these 7 clubs used their credit amounts against these invoices. Leaving just 2 clubs (2-223 & 3-444) still in credit, as they were not issued a quarterly invoice this quarter.

Some clubs don't seem to understand how a credit amount works. When the Centre issues you an invoice for either masterpoints or chargeable player movements, the invoiced total is for that scope of work. It will not include any credit amount your club may have at the time the invoice is issued or any other invoiced amounts still owing.

If your club does have a credit amount, then

the correct amount to pay is:

Invoiced Amt. LESS Credit Amt. = Amt. to Pay

Your quarterly Statement will show all issued invoices and all payments received. You can easily see if your club has overdue amounts owing, or if your club is in credit, and by how much.

You can always check online your club's current financial situation as well. Immediately after you logon to the **Web Site Management Login Page** you will see the total amount owed or the amount you are in credit. There are links provided for you to be able to see what is owed, or your credit amount, and you can use the option **Show Club Documents** to view/download any documents that have previously been emailed to your club which you may have misplaced.

ADMINISTRATION FEE

As mentioned in the last couple of Newsletters, the Administration Fee for not including your **CLUB NUMBER** with a payment, or for paying the Centre when the payment relates to another organization will take effect from the 1st July 2024.

For each instance of this occurring the club will be charged a \$10 administration fee at the end of each quarter to cover the cost of the extra work you have caused the Centre to do to sort out the issue.
